- God’s plan, Jesus plan and the Spirit’s plan.


The starting point

- **All people are the creation of God but all have sinned (Romans 3:28)**
- **The penalty for our sins is death and separation from God forever (Romans 6:23)**
- **Jesus Christ died to pay the penalty for our sins and was separated from God so that we don't have to be (John 3:16)**
- **We are invited to respond. Jesus meets the needs in our life (Matthew 11:28-30, Revelation 3:20, c 22:17)**
- **Promise of forgiveness and eternal life to all who come to Him in sincere repentance (Acts 4:12) John 6:37)**
- **We receive the Holy Spirit from God (John 14:26 & 2 Cor. 5:5) as a holy deposit from God a new life through Jesus.**
- **The universal truth of the gospel means good news to all people, to everyone (2 Cor. 5:14)**

Clear instructions

- Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know **how** to answer everyone. Col. 4:2-6
